- In case of a tie for High Point, highest place in Showmanship wins.
- Show reserves the right to combine or cancel classes.
- **MAKE ALL CHECKS PAYABLE TO "SMILES"**
- 3-minute gate hold will be enforced. An additional 3 minutes will be allowed for a requested tack change.
- Office Fee \$5 charged for each rider/horse combination. No office fee charged for Leadline only entries.
- Separate billing sheet required for each rider/horse combination
- All proceeds go to benefit SMILES Therapeutic Riding Program.
- Show will take place rain or shine.
- Fairgrounds require the use of shavings as bedding— available for sale at the show.
